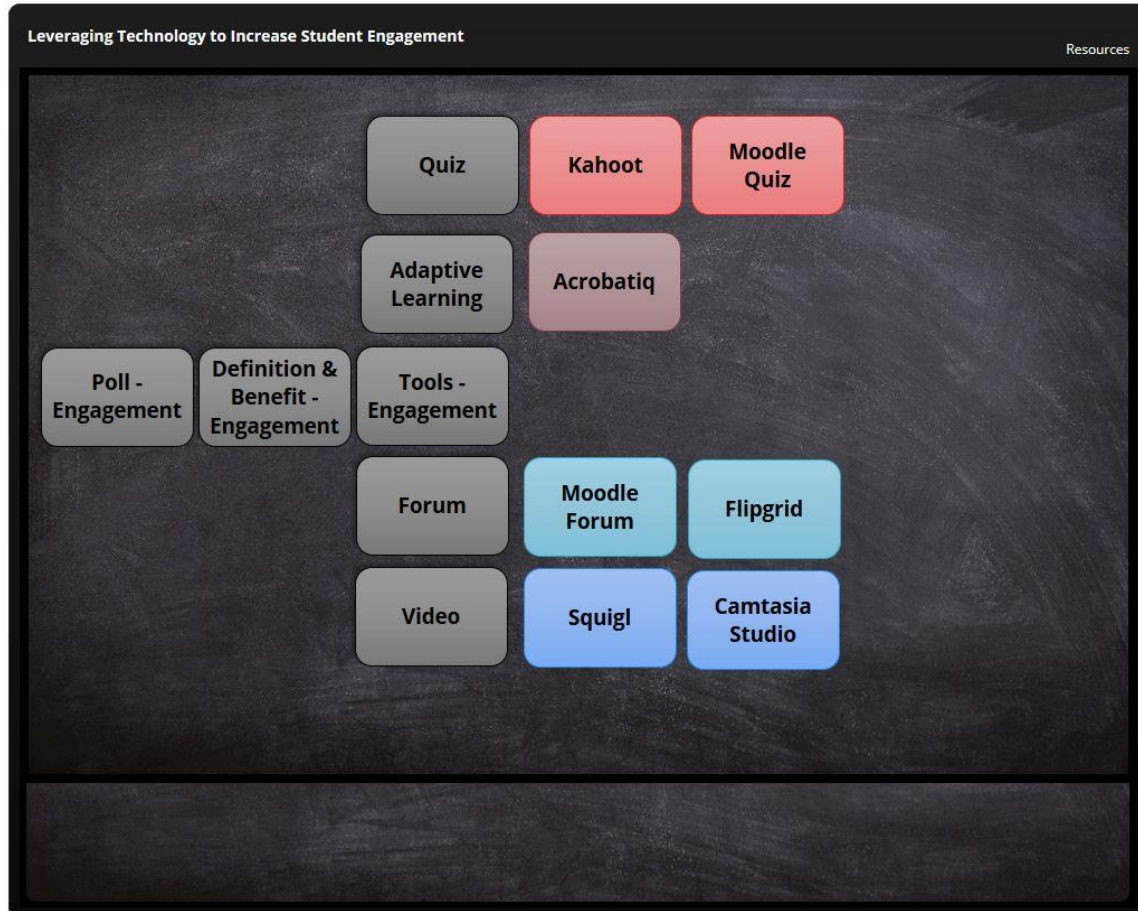

Definition & Benefit of Engagement

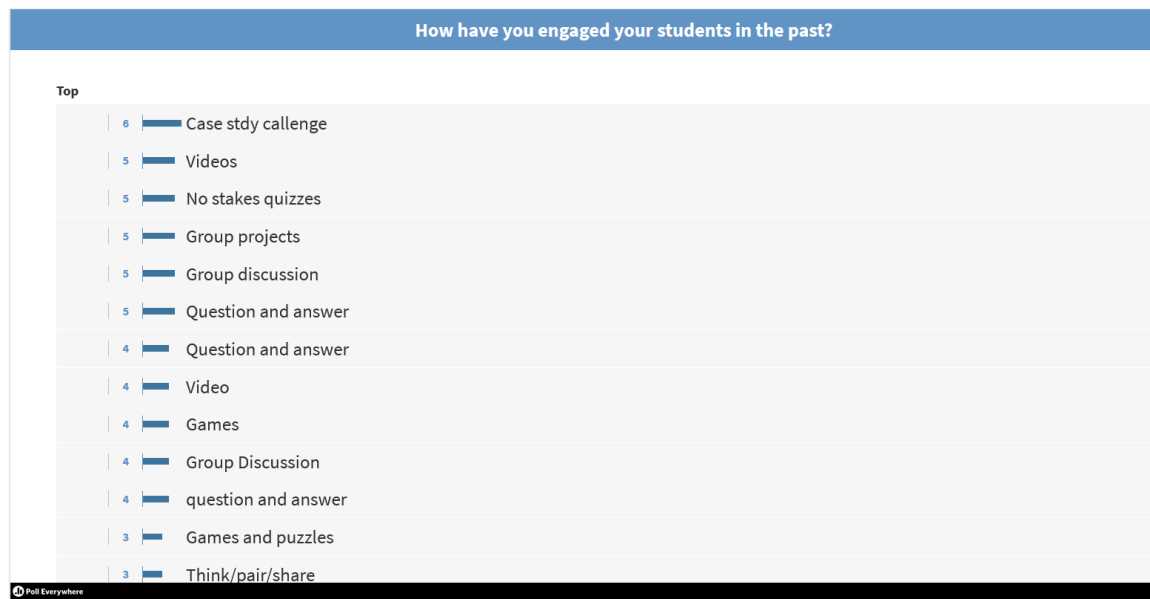


"Student engagement is concerned with the interaction between the time, effort and other relevant resources invested by both students and their institutions intended to optimize the student experience and enhance the learning outcomes and development of students and the performance, and reputation of the institution." (Trowler, 2010 p. 2)

When students are engaged, they tend to:

1. improve their critical thinking skills (Gellin 2003; Kuh, Hu & Vesper 1997 Pike & Killian 2001; Shulman 2002)
2. improve competency (Kuh, 1995) and grades (Astin, 1993; Tross, Harper Osher & Kneidinger 2000).
3. increase in persistence (Bean 2005; Berger & Milem 1999).



Research perspectives	Proposals for action
<i>Motivation and agency</i> (Engaged students are intrinsically motivated and want to exercise their agency)	1. Enhance students' self-belief
<i>Transactional engagement</i> (Students and teachers engage with each other)	2. Enable students to work autonomously, enjoy learning relationships with others and feel they are competent to achieve their own objectives
<i>Institutional support</i> (Institutions provide an environment conducive to learning)	3. Recognize that teaching and teachers are central to engagement
<i>Active citizenship</i> (Students and institutions work together to enable challenges to social beliefs and practices)	4. Create learning that is active, collaborative and fosters learning relationships
	5. Create educational experiences for students that are challenging, enriching and extend their academic abilities
	6. Ensure institutional cultures are welcoming to students from diverse backgrounds
	7. Invest in a variety of support services
	8. Adapt to changing student expectations
	9. Enable students to become active citizens
	10. Enable students to develop their social and cultural capital

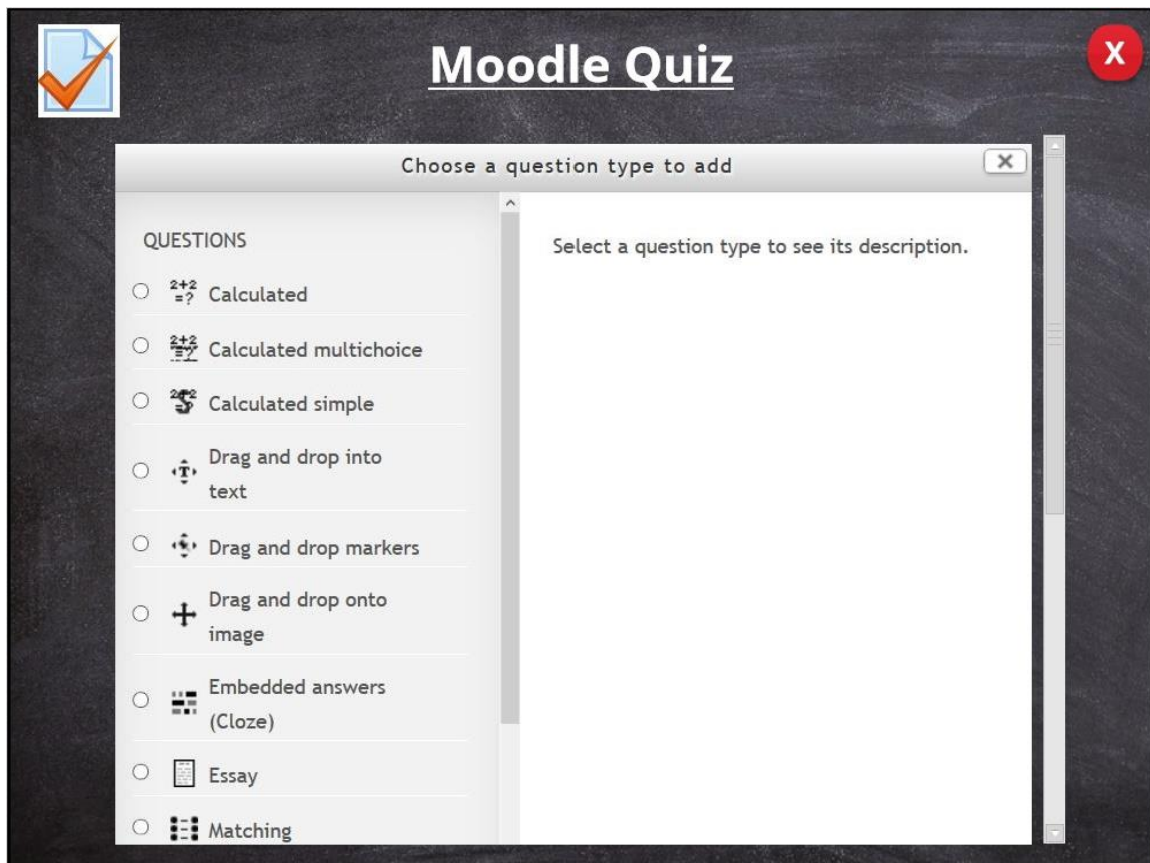

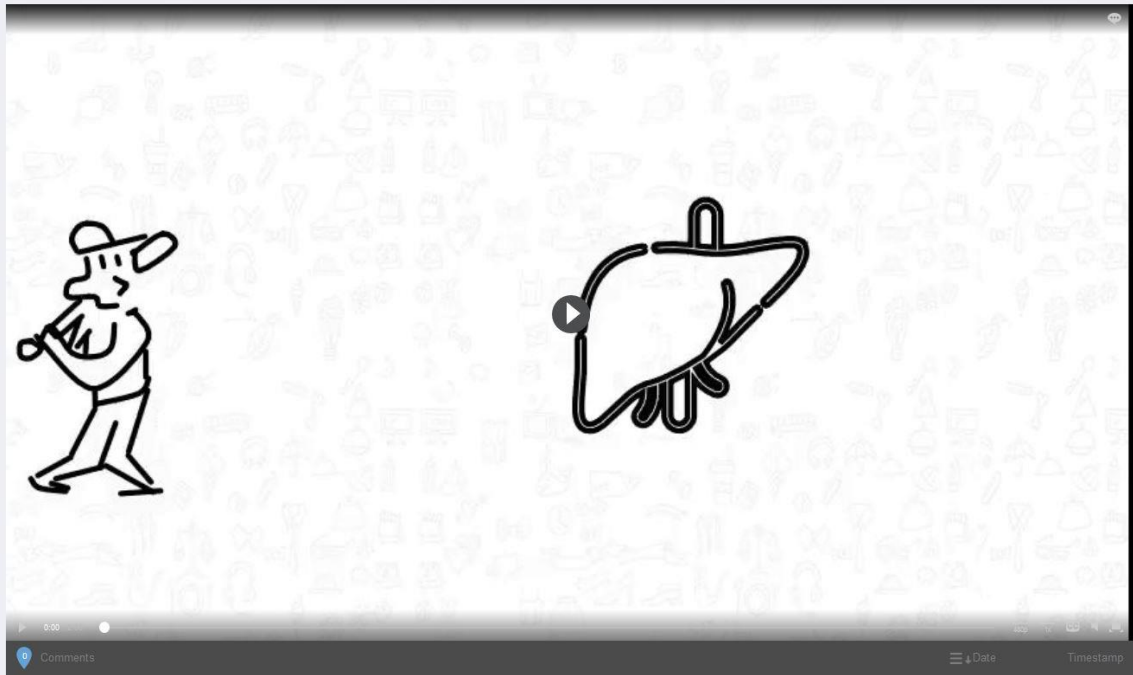

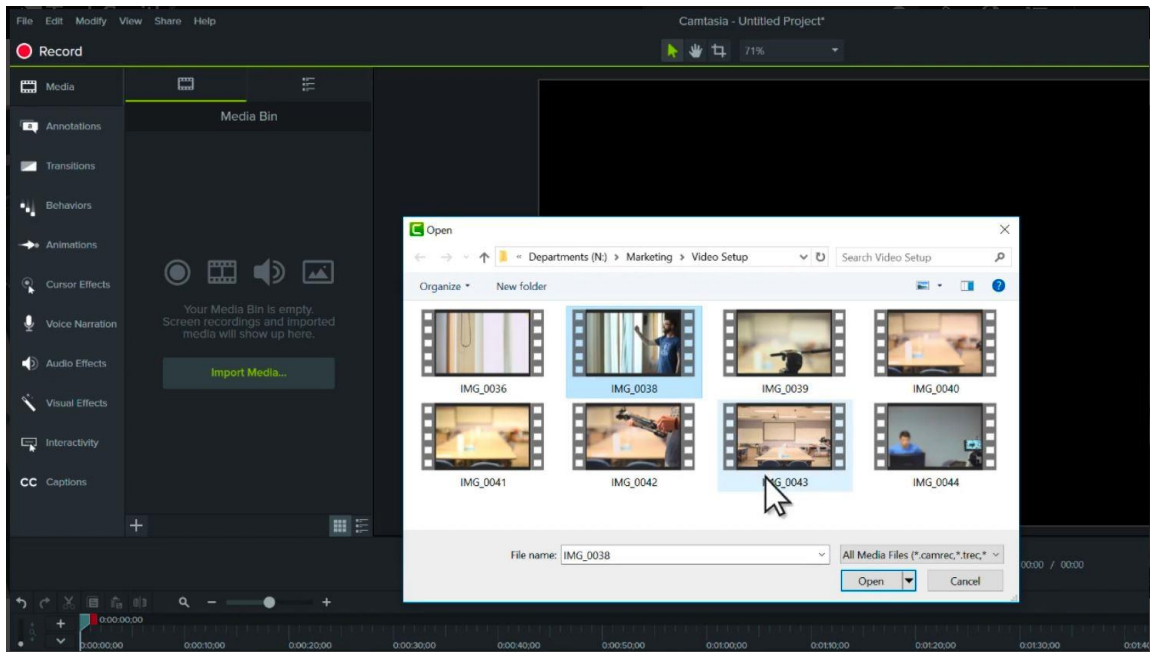
